

**Royal Canadian Mounted Police Places Order
for Anritsu S412E LMR Master™**

*— Handheld Analyzer Receives National Master Standing Offer from Public Works and
Government Services Canada —*

Morgan Hill, CA – April 23, 2012 – Anritsu Company announces that the Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC) Electronics, Munitions and Tactical Systems Procurement Directorate, Defense and Major Projects Sector has provided a National Master Standing Offer (NMSO) for the [S412E LMR Master™](#) handheld analyzer from Anritsu. Due in part to the NMSO, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) has purchased 18 LMR Masters and expects to buy more over a three-year period.

The purchase was made because the RCMP has a requirement for P25 Land Mobile Radio (LMR) spectrum analyzers. According to documents published by the Canadian government, Anritsu Electronics Ltd. was awarded the contract because “the [Anritsu S412E](#) is currently the only spectrum analyzer in the marketplace with all the selectable parameters for maintaining the RCMP Land Mobile Radio P25 Network. The spectrum analyzer must have the capabilities to analyze the P25 signals, including the P25 trunking control channel signal. In addition, the spectrum analyzer must provide a P25 mapping solution that can display a map on the analyzer which shows the P25 wireless network coverage measurements.”

David Witkowski, product manager at Anritsu, commented, “PWGSC’s issuance of a National Master Standing Offer for the [LMR Master S412E](#) is another example of Anritsu’s continued success at applying advanced technology solutions and voice-of-the-customer analysis towards solving real-world problems. Instead of simply providing incremental updates to traditional test and measurement, Anritsu listened to what leaders in the Land Mobile Radio industry were saying they needed in the field, and responded with a highly integrated and radically new approach to field test and measurement that has seen rapid adoption by customers ranging from end users to major radio manufacturers.”
